COMPASSION PROJECTS (\$25,000 TOTAL GOAL)

Times of Refreshing

- Build Solar Powered Well in Zimbabwe
- Goal = \$8,000 (total cost of 1 well)

These solar-powered wells are built in conjunction with a local Assembly of God church in Zimbabwe. Each well meets a desperate physical need and positions the church as the center of the community.

- Disaster Relief from Tornadoes in Kentucky
- Goal = \$7,000 towards Disaster Relief Efforts

Christ in Action is an international relief organization based out of Virginia. Christ Chapel has partnered with C.I.A. on several occasions including sending a team to Louisiana after last year's Hurricane Delta. C.I.A. teams are currently in Kentucky to serve and assist homeowners who have been impacted by the recent tornadoes.

- Thitali Outreach Center in Southern Asia
- Goal = \$5,000 towards total renovation cost \$746,416

From Brothel to Beacon of Light. Project Rescue had the opportunity to buy a building that was once a brothel located in one of the biggest red-light districts in southern Asia. Now it is being re-purposed to help rescue women and girls from the horrors of human trafficking. The goal is to empower these young women as they hear the gospel and receive encouragement, education, and job training.

- Hope Center Project for homeless in Prince William County
- Goal = \$5.000

StreetLight ministers to the homeless population in P.W.C by providing a Supportive Housing Program, Homeless Prevention Program, Food Pantry and Clothing Closet, Homeless Campsite Outreach and a weekly Community Outreach Dinner to the Homeless. They are currently in the process of developing The Hope Center, which will provide temporary housing as well as job training and in-house medical assistance. Christ Chapel has partnered with Streetlight in ministering to the homeless over the last several years.

CHILDREN FOCUSED PROJECTS (\$25,000 TOTAL GOAL)

C.A.L.M. Children's Center

- Rebuild/repair from typhoon in Philippians
- Goal = \$10,000 towards \$100,000 total project cost

CALM Children's Center was established for the physical and spiritual growth of over 100 children providing much needed meals and teaching of the Word of God. In December, Typhoon Odette tore a path of destruction across the area completely destroying 4 buildings and damaging many more. Christ Chapel has support the ongoing ministry of C.A.L.M. for several years and will be partnering with them to overcome the devastating impact of these storms.

- Hope School Feeding Program in Congo
- Goal = \$8,000 (one year feeding initiative)

Hope School is affiliated with Global Grace ministries and is a primary school offering meals to children in an impoverished area of the Congo.





Joshua House Life Center

- Life Center Repairs in Ukraine
- Goal = \$7,000

Joshua House Life Center includes a children's home as well as a church comprised almost entirely of children and youth, who are actively involved in all aspects of the ministry, including its many outreaches to the poor and needy, orphaned, and widowed, sick and elderly. The Life Center is in dire need of repairs.



CHURCH PLANTS (\$20,000 TOTAL GOAL)

Eurasia. AGWM. Robbie & Sarah Hereth. \$5,000

Pastor Sarah was formerly on staff with Christ Chapel. Sarah and Robbie have been assigned to plant the first Assembly of God church in a newly open area in the Eurasia. They are currently developing a ministry team and will be launching the new church in the fall of 2022.

Northern India. AGWM. Greg Hubbard. \$7,000

The Assemblies of God has recently planted dozens of house churches throughout northern India. These churches are growing quickly and several of these churches now average over 100 people. A complete church building can be built for \$7,000. This missionary has been to Christ Chapel in the past and is open for mission trips and short-term service opportunities.

The Maunda Family will be a ministry guest at Christ Chapel this spring. They are missionaries currently planting a new church among the Datooga People in a remote area of Tanzania.

Ashville, NC. Mountaintop. Masco & Jerrie Settles. \$3,000

Masco and Jerrie Settles were long time members of Christ Chapel and Jerrie spent several years working for CCA. They have been led to plant a new Assembly of God church in Ashville, North Carolina and have already moved to Ashville to begin the work.

 Adopt a specific project for the expansion of student housing for ministry students.

Fire Bibles. Haiti/Creole Fire Bibles. \$15,000 https://www.firebible.org/

 The translation and distribution of the Bible to unreached people groups. This specific project is translating the Bible to Creole for the people of Haiti. These Bibles will be distributed in schools as well as through local outreach efforts.

Christ Chapel Church Scholarships. \$5,000

 Sponsoring scholarships for youth from Christ Chapel Church who attend Christian Universities. A review panel and process would be put in place to determine guidelines and distribution on a yearly basis.
